- Divisions:** Boys: 1st, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup> Girls: 2nd 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup>
- Special Rules:**
1. 7<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> graders can only play on a team made up of players from the same school. **NO EXCEPTIONS.** School coaches may not coach teams of the same sex, grades 7-12.
  2. A player may play for only One team during league play.
  3. Girls cannot play on boys teams, Boys cannot play on girls teams.
  4. Entry Fee **will not be refunded** after the Deadline Date if you drop from the league.
- Game Days:** April 16, April 23, April 30, May 7, May 14, May 21, May 28  
Any **team** that can't play on any of these days will forfeit the game and another team will fill in to give the opposing team a game. The Team that can't play will lose 15-0.
- Final Team Sign-up:** March 31, 2005 is the deadline. **No sign up meetings this year.**
- Entry Fees:** \$180 based on 6 games. Card fee is NOT included in the entry fee. Any checks that are returned NSF will be charged a \$35.00 fee. **(No Entry fee refund after the Deadline Date)**
- Club Membership:** **\$60.00 club fee for any club that is going to run a AAU sanctioned event.**  
\$30.00 club fee, includes accident and liability insurance for players and coaches at games and practice. More than one team can be from the same club, but they must be organized as a club. Clubs are good from September 1, 2004 to August 31, 2005.  
(All teams must have be a member of a club)
- AAU Membership:** 2005 AAU cards will be used for league Player \$12.00 Coach \$14.00. All players and coaches must have an AAU Card. **NOTE:** Anyone that coaches the team from the bench must also have an AAU card. 2005 AAU cards are valid through August 31, 2005. **Membership cards don't get you into the game for free.** Only players that are playing are allowed into the game Free. One Coach and One Scorekeeper are allowed into game for free, but must sign-in.

- Entry Deadline:** March 31, 2005: **NO LATE ENTRIES.** Please send entry info in early. You can add players at any time as long as they have a 2005 AAU card on file. A time line and information page will be mailed to all contact persons after the receipt of entry by the YVSA office.
- Rules of play:** 2004-2005 High School Rules will be played.  
Woman's size basketball will be used for all divisions except Boys 7<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup> grades.  
Quarters: 6 minute 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> grades 7 minute 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup> grades, 8 minute 9<sup>th</sup> Grade
- SPECIAL RULE:** Technical or Intentional fouls – 2 points awarded and ball out of bounds.  
One technical foul on a coach or fan and he/she is ejected from the gym. One Technical on a player, the player sits on the bench for the remainder of the game. Officials and Gym Administrators have the right to eject a fan. Coaches and Fans must leave the entire gym or game will be a forfeit and the team could be sanctioned and dropped from the league.
- Forfeit Time:** Game Time, no exceptions.
- Scorekeeper:** Each team is to have **ONE** person to keep the individual score sheet that is provided by the AAU at the score bench. One scorekeeper will be allowed into the game at no charge. Score sheets provided by the AAU, must be left with the gym supervisor.
- Coaches:** Only **ONE** coach per team is allowed into the game free, but more than one may coach, but must pay and have an AAU card to sit on the bench.
- Game Times:** 9:00am, 10:15am, 11:30am, 12:45pm, 2:00pm, 3:15pm, 4:30pm
- Admission:** The gyms are run by clubs. The money for admissions goes back into their clubs for youth activities. This is the only way that we can run the league. Please inform your parents.
