- Same School:** Teams in the 7th and 8th Grade must come from the same school, Multi school teams will be rejected.
- Entry Fee:** \$150 Make checks out to Yakima Valley Sports Authority YVSA
Any checks returned NSF will require a \$35 charge
We except Visa or Master Charge, add a \$7.50 convenient fee.
- Games:** All teams will play four (4) or five (5) games.
- Game Times:** Friday: 5:30pm, 6:50pm, 8:10pm, 9:30pm, (All teams will play on Friday night)

- AAU Membership:** All athletes and head coaches that participate in any AAU event must have a 2005 AAU card. Athlete membership cards cost \$12 and coach cards are \$14. These cards are valid September 1, 2004 – August 31, 2005 for all sanctioned AAU events in any of the sports that make up the AAU program. The membership provides the best supplemental accident insurance for the athlete during official practices and sanctioned competitions.
- Grade Determining Date:** The grade the participant is as of March 1, 2005.
- Roster:** The roster established at the time of the first game must be used throughout the entire tournament. No additions or changes are permitted. Players must have cards purchased in advance to participate. Memberships purchase online at www.ieaaau.org
- Rules:** 2004-2005 High School Federation Rules. Special Technical Foul Rule: Any technical or intentional foul, two points awarded and the ball out of bounds. Check coaches letter in your packet you will receive at the gym of your first game for additional rules.
