- Entry Fee:** \$150 Make checks out to Yakima Valley Sports Authority YVSA  
Any checks returned NSF will require a \$35 charge.

- Games:** All teams will play four (4) or five (5) games.
- Game Times:** Friday: (All teams play Friday) 5:30pm, 6:50pm, 8:10pm, 9:30pm  
Saturday and Sunday: 9:00am, 10:20am, 11:40am, 1:00pm, 2:20pm, 3:40pm, 5:00pm, 6:20pm
- AAU Membership:** All athletes and head coaches that participate in any AAU event must have a 2005 AAU card. Athlete membership cards cost \$12 and coach cards are \$14. These cards are valid September 1, 2004 – August 31, 2005 for all sanctioned AAU events in any of the sports that make up the AAU program. The membership provides the best supplemental accident insurance for the athlete during official practices and sanctioned competitions.
- Grade Determining Date:** The grade the participant in as of March 1, 2005.
- Roster:** The roster established at the time of the first game must be used throughout the entire tournament. No additions or changes are permitted. Players must have cards purchased in advance to participate.
- Rules:** 2004-2005 High School Federation Rules. Special Technical Foul Rule: Any technical foul or intentional foul, two points awarded and the ball out of bounds. Check coach’s letter in your packet you will receive at the gym of your first game for additional rules.
- Awards:** Individual and Team awards based on one set per four teams.
