

2005 AAU "Three Rivers" Summer Youth Basketball League

- Entry Fee:** \$240.00, We except Visa or master Charge, add a \$12.00 handling charge. No Refunds after the Deadline of May 17, 2005.
- Games:** Eight (8) Played in a four week period June 1st-June 30th. Games will be played on Monday Thursday ONLY. Teams that have a team camp will have to play three games on two of the weeks if they are unavailable to play during one of the weeks of play. **High School Teams will not start Play until June 6th so that High School Coaches can take part.**
- Entry Deadline:** May 17th (Postmark) , No team entry fee refunds after May 17th.
- Game Sites:** High School Coaches that have a gym site that they would like to use for the league, please contact Paul Campbell for information. We have been expanding our league into the Tri-Cities this year. Franklin and Benton County High School coaches are encourage to participate in this league.

- Divisions:** Boys: and Girls: 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th, 8th, 9th, Soph, JV, Varsity
- Special Rules:** 8th graders through High School can **only play** on a team made up of players from the same school. **NO EXCEPTIONS.** A player may play for only **ONE team** during league play.
- Club Membership:** \$30.00 club fee, includes accident and liability insurance for players and coaches at games and practice. More than one team can be from the same club, but they must be organized as a club. Clubs are good from September 1, 2004 to August 31, 2005.
- AAU Membership:** 2005 AAU cards will be used for league. All players must have an AAU Card. **NOTE:** Anyone that coaches the team from the bench must also have an AAU card in 2005. 2005 AAU cards are valid through August 31, 2005. Go to www.ieaaau.org and order cards through the internet.
- AAU Card Fee:** Player \$12.00 Coach \$14.00, We except Visa or Master Charge, we will add 5% convenience fee. Go to www.ieaaau.org and order cards through the internet.
- Entry Deadline:** Postmark Deadline May 17, 2005 **NO LATE ENTRIES.** Please send entry info in early. You can add players at any time as long as they have a 2005 AAU card on file.
- Rules of play:** 2005-2006 High School Rules will be played.
Girls only – No 30 second clock, over and back will be called
Half-time 5 minutes
Woman's size basketball will be used for all divisions except Boys 7th through High School.
Quarters: 6 minutes 2nd, 3rd, 4th grades 7 minutes 5th, 6th, 7th, 8th grades 8 minutes all others.
SPECIAL RULE: Technical fouls and Intentional fouls – 2 points awarded and ball out of bounds.
One technical foul on a player during the game for sportsmanship and the player is disqualified.
One technical foul on the coach during the game for sportsmanship, coach must leave the gym.
- Forfeit Time:** Game Time.
- Scorekeeper:** Each team is to have **ONE** person to keep the individual score sheet that is provided by the AAU at the score bench. One scorekeeper will be allowed into the game at no charge. Score sheets provided by the AAU, must be left with the gym supervisor. (This year the one coach and Scorekeeper must sign in, remember only two individuals are allowed into a game free) This gives you the right to watch games in that gym only)
- Coaches:** Only **ONE** coach per team is allowed into the game free, but more than one may coach. (Free admission coach must sign in)
- Game Times:** 6:00pm, 7:20pm, 8:40pm
- Admission:** The gyms are run by clubs. The money goes back into their clubs for youth activities. This is the only way that we can run the league.
