FILLING DIVISIONS:

There is a limit on the total number of games the facilities will accommodate. Entries will be accepted on a first received, first honored basis, and balanced between divisions to provide the maximum opportunity for teams to participate.

AAU MEMBERSHIP:

All athletes that participate in any AAU event must have a 2004/05 AAU card and each team must be from an AAU club. ROSTER:

The roster established at the time of the first game must be used throughout the entire tournament. No additions or changes are permitted. A roster limit of ten players is established for this tournament.

RULES:

- ** High School Federation Rules will be applied.
- ** Special Technical Foul Rule: Any technical foul will result in award of an automatic two points to the team, plus the ball out of bounds.
- ** The 28 _ inch women's ball will be used, except for 7th and 8th Grade Boy's Games.
- ** Quarter times will be 6 minutes for 4th, 5th and 6th Grade Teams; 7 minutes for 7th and 8th Grade Teams.
- ** There is no 30 second clock for Girl's Games.
- ** A press is not allowed with a 15+ point lead.

OFFICIATING:

Two (2) registered association officials will be used, with electronic scoreboards in each gym.

AWARDS:

Individual awards to the players on the top two teams in each Division.
