Friday Games: Fridays will not be used unless numbers of entries dictate or scheduling conflicts arise. If you have a special request for time and/or day you would like to play, please indicate on your entry. We can't guarantee all requests will be honored, but we will try.

Limited Entries: 8 teams per division. The first 8 rosters WITH fees will be guaranteed entry into the tournament. More than 8 teams may be allowed if overall numbers permit.

Number of Games: Each team is guaranteed a minimum of 4 games. The possibility exists for some teams to play 5 games. Tournament is pool play or single elimination to the championship rounds. Additional games will be provided to insure the four game minimum for each team.

Entry Fee: \$160.00 per team. Due by entry deadline date (ABOVE).

AAU Membership: All players must have a 2004 AAU membership card. Cards must be purchased and returned in advance. All rosters will be checked individuals without cards will cause a team to be disqualified. Card fee is not included in the entry fee.

First Game Time: Each team should receive a packet with game times and locations by the Monday before your tournament starting date. If you have not received your packet by the Tuesday before the tournament, call 509-925-8017 between 8:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. for your first game time and location. Each coach will receive another packet with scoresheets and any last minute schedule changes at your first game.

Rosters: The roster established at the time of the first game must be used throughout the entire tournament. No additions or changes are permitted. Players must have AAU cards purchased in advance to participate.

Awards: The top two teams in each division will receive trophies. Up to 10 individual awards are given to each team that receives a team trophy.

Gym Sites: Ellensburg High School, Central Washington University, Kittitas High School, Thorp High School, Morgan Middle School, Kittitas Middle School, Valley View Elementary, Mt. Stuart Elementary, and Lincoln Elementary gyms.

2004-2005 High School Federation Rules.
Women's size basketball will be used for all divisions except boys 7th & 8th grades.
There are no tournament game balls. "Best ball" available will be used.
Quarters: 6 minutes - 4th: 7 minutes - 5th, 6th, 7th, 8th

Special Rules:

Technical Fouls - 2 points awarded and ball out of bounds.
Intentional Fouls - 2 points awarded and ball out of bounds.
The bench rule - Coaches must sit on the bench during the game - except to applaud a good play, call a time out, or get a sub into the game.

Forfeit Time:

Game time.

Warm-up:

5 minutes minimum after previous game or game time, whichever is longer.

Scorekeeper:

Each team is to have one person keep the individual score sheet that will be provided.
One scorekeeper per team will be admitted free.

Coaches:

Only one coach per team allowed into game free, but more than one may coach.
