I wanted to introduce myself to you, I'm Paul Campbell, I have been running the AAU Programs in Eastern Washington and Northern Idaho for the past 30 years. During that time we have provided a chance to participate in organized AAU programs to over 400,000 young athletes in over 15,000 individual events. We have over 17,000 individuals involved in our program each year. Many of you may have participated as an athlete in the AAU, we hope that you have seen the value of this organization.

In 2008, we are taking over a league that was started a couple years ago by Jeremy McCreary, like any young adult, has found that this takes many hours to do right. He called me up and asked if I could take over the management of the league.

We are going to run the league the same way that we have done it in the Yakima Valley. Shannon Springer, is the day to day contact for this league. We have a 1 800 228 4872 number set up for communications. We will be developing an officials pool to work the games. Cost is the same as leagues in the Yakima Valley. Admission Fees will be charged and that money will go back to the school or club programs that manage the gyms. Win Win. In 2007 the individual clubs and schools in the Yakima Valley generated over \$170,000.00 back to them through our program of sharing.

There may be bumps in the road, but we will be fare.

We will be running multiple leagues in the future. We want to make sure that teams have a chance to play basketball and other sports. We have been successful in what we have provided in the past, we want to bring the same to the North Central Washington Area.

Game Days: December 1, 8, 15, January 12, 19, 26, February 2, 9
Teams will play on 6 of the 8 days of league play. You may ask for 2 "bye" weekends in order to participate in local AAU tournaments in the Chelan, Leavenworth and Wenatchee communities.
- Game Times:** All games on Saturdays: 9:00am, 10:15am, 11:30am, 12:45pm, 2:00pm, 3:15pm, 4:30pm
- Divisions:** Boys: 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th, 8th Girls: 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th, 8th
- Entry Fees:** \$220 based on 6 games. Membership fees are **NOT** included in the entry fee. Any checks that are returned NSF will be charged a \$35.00 fee. **No entry fees refunded after the deadline date.**
- AAU Membership:** **2008 AAU cards will be used for the league: Player \$12.00 Coach \$14.00.**
Memberships can be purchased online: www.aausports.org. All players and coaches must have an AAU Card. **NOTE:** Anyone that coaches the team from the bench must have an AAU card. 2008 AAU cards are valid September 1, 2007 - August 31, 2008. **If it is found that a player is participating without a current AAU card, your team will be subject to forfeits of games with no refund of league fees paid.**
- REMEMBER: Membership cards don't get you into the game for free.** Only players that are playing are allowed into the game free.
- League Rules:**
1. 7th & 8th grade teams **MUST BE MADE UP OF PLAYERS FROM THE SAME SCHOOL.**
NO EXCEPTIONS (League Only).
WIAA rules state school coaches may not coach teams of the same sex, grades 7-12.
 2. A player may play for only **ONE** team during league play.
 3. Girls cannot play on boys teams and boys cannot play on girls teams.
 4. Entry fees will not be refunded after the deadline if you drop from the league.
 5. Teams will not be allowed to play until all membership cards and club membership has been purchased. **COACH:** It is your responsibility that ALL players on your team have current AAU cards. Failure to do so will result in your removal from the league with no refund of fees paid.
- Rules of play:** 2007-2008 High School Rules will be played.
1st thru 6th grade boys and all girls divisions will use the women's size basketball (28.5").
1st – 4th grades: 6 minute quarters / 5th – 8th grades: 7 minute quarters
Overtime 2 minutes.
- Special Rule:** Technical or Intentional fouls – 2 points awarded and ball out of bounds.
One technical foul on a coach or fan and he/she is ejected from the gym. One technical on a player, the player sits on the bench for the remainder of the game. Officials and Gym Administrators have the right to eject a fan, player or coach. Coaches and fans must leave the **entire gym** or game will be a forfeit and the team could be sanctioned and dropped from the league.
Two technical fouls in the season on a player or a coach, they are removed completely from the league. NO EXCEPTIONS!
- Forfeit Time:** Game Time - no exceptions.
- Scorekeeper:** Each team is to have **ONE** person to keep the individual score sheet that is provided by YVSA at the score bench. One scorekeeper will be allowed into the game at no charge. Score sheets provided by the YVSA and must be left with the gym supervisor.
- Coaches:** Only **ONE** coach per team is allowed into the game free, but more than one may coach, but must pay and have an AAU card to sit on the bench.
- Admission:** The gyms are run by clubs. The money from admissions goes back into their clubs for youth activities. This is the only way that we can run the league. Please inform your parents.
ADULTS: \$2.00 STUDENTS: \$1.00
