Any checks returned NSF will require a \$25 charge. We except Visa or Master Charge.

For Visa/Master Charge we add a \$7.50 handling charge.

**AAU Membership:** All athletes and head coaches that participate in any AAU event must have a 2001 AAU

card. Athlete membership cards cost \$10 and coach cards are \$12. These cards are valid September 1, 2000 – August 31, 2001 for all sanctioned AAU events in any of the sports that make up the AAU program. The membership provides the best supplemental accident insurance for the athlete during official practices and sanctioned competitions.

We except Visa or Master Charge., add a 5% handling charge.

**Age Determining Date:** The grade the participant in as of March 1, 2001.

**Roster:** The roster established at the time of the first game must be used throughout the entire

tournament. No additions or changes are permitted. Players must have cards purchased

in advance to participate.

**Rules:** 2000-2001 High School Federation Rules. Special Technical Foul Rule: Any technical

foul, two points awarded and the ball out of bounds. Check coaches letter in your packet

you will receive at the gym of your first game for additional rules.

**Awards:** Individual awards to three teams in each division. Team plaques to the top three teams.
