

## Ellensburg 2000-2001 Basketball Tournaments Sponsored by Ellensburg Community Schools Sanctioned by the Inland Empire AAU

NOTE:	Fridays will not be used unless numbers of entries dictate. If you have a special request for time and/or day, please indicate it on your entry.							
Limited Entries:	8 teams per division. The first 8 rosters and fees will be guaranteed entry into the tournament. More than 8 teams may be allowed if overall numbers permit.							
Number of Games:	Each team is guaranteed a minimum of 4 games. The possibility exists for some teams to play 5 games. Tournament is pool play or single elimination to the championship game. Additional games will be provided to insure the four game minimum for each team.							
Entry Fee:	\$140.00 per team.							
AAU Membership:	All players must have a 2001 AAU membership card. Cards must be purchased and returned in advance. Please inquire at the Inland Empire AAU office: PO Box 9603, Yakima, WA 98909 - 509-453-2696. All rosters will be checked, individuals without cards will cause a team to be disqualified. Card fee is not included in the entry fee. You must include AAU card numbers on the entry form.							
First Game Time:	Each team should receive a packet with game times and locations by the Monday before your tournament starting date. If you have not received your packet by the Tuesday before the tournament, call 509-925-8017 between 8:00am and 5:00pm for your first game time and location. Each coach will receive another packet with scoresheets and any last minute schedule changes at your first game.							
Rosters:	The roster established at the time of the first game must be used throughout the entire tournament. No additions or changes are permitted. Players must have AAU cards purchased in advance to participate.							
Awards:	The top two teams in each division will receive trophies. Up to 10 individual trophies are awarded to each team that receives a team trophy.							
Gym Sites:	Ellensburg High School, Valley View Elementary, Morgan Middle School, Lincoln Elementary, Mt. Stuart Elementary, Kittitas High School, Kittitas Middle School, Thorp High School, and Central Washington University gyms.							
Game Times:	Saturday & Sunday -	Friday - 5:30pm, 6:40pm, 7:50pm, 9:00pm (If Friday is used). Faturday & Sunday - 8:30am, 9:45am, 11:00am, 12:15pm, 1:30pm, 2:45pm, 4:00pm, 15pm, 6:30pm, 7:45pm

Rules of Play:	2000-2001 High School Federation Rules. Women's size basketball will be used for all divisions except boys 7th & 8th grades. There are no tournament game balls. "Best ball" available will be used. Quarters: 6 minutes 4th, 5th, 6th 7 minutes 7th, 8th SPECIAL RULE: Technical fouls - 2 points awarded and ball out of bounds. The bench rule - Coaches must sit on the bench during the game - except to applaud a good play, call a time out, or get a sub into the game.				
Forfeit Time:	Game time.				
Warm-up:	10 minutes minimum after previous game or game time, whichever is longer.				
Scorekeeper:	Each team is to have one person keep the individual scoresheet that will be provided. One scorekeeper per team will be admitted free.				
Coaches:	Only one coach per team allowed into game free, but more than one may coach.				
Admission:	Friday - Adults \$2.00 Students \$1.00 Saturday & Sunday - Adults \$3.00 Students \$2.00 - Good ALL DAY Children four and under are admitted FREE. All money goes to support Ellensburg Youth Activities.				
T-Shirts:	Tournament T-shirts that are pre-ordered are \$12 each and there will be a very limited supply of shirts on sale during the tournament for \$15.
