Each team must be represented and entry fees paid at this time or the team will NOT participate in the league.

Entry Fees: \$160 based on 6 games. Card fee is NOT included in the entry fee. Any checks that are

Practice Insurance: \$30.00 club fee, includes accident and liability insurance for players and coaches at games and

practice. More than one team can be from the same club, but they must be organized as a club. Clubs

AAU Membership: 2001 AAU cards will be used for league. All players must have an AAU Card. **NOTE:** Anyone that

coaches the team from the bench must also have an AAU card in 2001. 2001 AAU cards are valid

through August 31, 2001.

Entry Deadline: At meeting, **NO LATE ENTRIES**. Please send entry info in early. You can add players at any time

as long as they have a 2001 AAU card on file. All money must be paid at the meeting.

Rules of play: 2000-2001 High School Rules will be played.

Woman's size basketball will be used for all divisions except Boys 7th and 8th grades.

Quarters: 6 minutes 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th grades 7 minutes 5th, 6th, 7th, 8th grades SPECIAL RULE: Technical fouls – 2 points awarded and ball out of bounds.

One technical foul on a coach and he is ejected from the gym.
