REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Tournament Location: All Tournament games will occur in or around Spokane, Washington.

Team Entry Fee : \$170.00, not including any AAU membership cards or membership fees required. Make checks payable to **Spokane Regional AAU Club**. Each team will receive four scheduled games.

How to Register: To register, please complete the enclosed "Team Entry" form. Entry forms will be accepted if postmarked by December 15, 2000. Entries postmarked after December 15, 2000 will be placed on a waiting list.

Who May Participate : This tournament is a sanctioned AAU event and is open to all boys and girls teams in grades fourth through ninth. All athletes that participate in any AAU sanctioned event must have a 2000-2001 AAU Card. A membership Card costs \$10.00/12.00. The Card is valid for all sanctioned AAU events during the 2000-2001 year. The membership Card provides supplemental accident insurance for each athlete during official practices and sanctioned competitions. All coaches sitting on the bench must have a 2000-2001 AAU Coach's Card, which costs \$12.00/14.00. The AAU Cards must be purchased through an AAU office. The Cards must be on hand with all participants (players and coaches) throughout tournament play. Only players listed on the "Team Entry" form are eligible to participate in this tournament. Game and/or tournament suspensions may be given to any team utilizing a player not properly registered. Roster additions and changes will not be accepted after December 22, 2000 at 4:00 PM.

Membership Fees: Tournament teams without membership in an AAU sanctioned Club Basketball Program for the 2000-2001 season must purchase a Club Membership, at the cost of \$30.00. The Membership may be purchased through Spokane Regional AAU. For example, all teams that are participating in the 2000-2001 Spokane Regional AAU Basketball League are members of that Club and are not required to pay an additional membership fee.

Rule : High School Federation Rules will be in effect, with exception of the following two rules: Special Technical Foul Rule - With any technical foul, the award will be an automatic two (2) points for the opposing team and they will receive the ball out of bounds. A Technical Foul also counts as a personal foul. No Press Rule - When a team is 15 points ahead, the leading team cannot full court press. They may pick up at half court. One warning will be given to the bench prior to a technical being assessed.

Awards: Awards will be presented to the first and second place team, in each grade level.

Admission: Entrance fees will be as follows: **Day Pass** – Adult (over 18) \$4.00, Child (11-18) \$2.00. **Tournament Pass** – Adult (over 18) \$7.00, Child (11-18) \$3.00. (Children 10 years and younger will be admitted free of charge.)

The Fine Print: Spokane Regional AAU has the right to limit the number of teams playing in this tournament. It may also cancel play in a specific division, should a minimum number of teams fail to register for that division. In that unique situation, a team's entry fee will be refunded.
