- Divisions:** Boys: 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th, 8th Girls: 2nd 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th, 8th
- Special Rules:**
1. 7th and 8th graders can only play on a team made up of players from the same school. **NO EXCEPTIONS.** School coaches may not coach teams of the same sex, grades 7-12.
 2. A player may play for only ONE team during league play.
- Game Days:** January 20, January 27, February 3, February 10, February 17, February 24, March 3
Any **team** that can't play on any of these days will forfeit the game and another team will fill in to give the opposing team a game.
- Coaches Meeting:** Wednesday, January 3rd: meeting to be held at Cavanaugh's Yakima Center, 607 E. Yakima Ave. 6:00-7:00 p.m. sign-up, 7:00-7:45 p.m. meeting. Sign-up will continue after the meeting.
Thursday, January 4th: meeting to be held at Kiona Benton High School Gym Lobby, Benton City. 6:00-7:00 p.m. sign-up, 7:00-7:45 p.m. meeting. Sign-up will continue after the meeting.
***1st time teams must attend the sign-up for important information. Teams that have all-ready signed up for the league with entry fees sent in do not have to attend.**
- Entry Fees:** \$160 based on 6 games. Card fee is NOT included in the entry fee. Any checks that are returned NSF will be charged a \$25.00 fee.
- Practice Insurance:** \$30.00 club fee, includes accident and liability insurance for players and coaches at games and practice. More than one team can be from the same club, but they must be organized as a club. Clubs are good from September 1, 2000 to August 31, 2001.
- AAU Membership:** 2001 AAU cards will be used for league. All players must have an AAU Card. **NOTE:** Anyone that coaches the team from the bench must also have an AAU card in 2001. 2001 AAU cards are valid through August 31, 2001.
- AAU Card Fee:** Player \$10.00 Coach \$12.00
- Entry Deadline:** At meeting, **NO LATE ENTRIES.** Please send entry info in early. You can add players at any time as long as they have a 2001 AAU card on file.
- Rules of play:** 2000-2001 High School Rules will be played.
Woman's size basketball will be used for all divisions except Boys 7th and 8th grades.
Quarters: 6 minute 2nd, 3rd, 4th grades 7 minute 5th, 6th, 7th, 8th grades
SPECIAL RULE: Technical fouls – 2 points awarded and ball out of bounds.
One technical foul on a coach and he is ejected from the gym.
The bench rule: Coaches must sit on the bench during the game (Except to applaud good play, call time out, or get a sub into the game).
- Forfeit Time:** Game Time.
- Scorekeeper:** Each team is to have **ONE** person to keep the individual score sheet that is provided by the AAU at the score bench. One scorekeeper will be allowed into the game at no charge. Score sheets provided by the AAU, must be left with the gym supervisor.
- Coaches:** Only **ONE** coach per team is allowed into the game free, but more than one may coach.
- Game Times:** 9:00am, 10:15am, 11:30am, 12:45pm, 2:00pm, 3:15pm or later in some gyms.
- Admission:** The gyms are run by clubs. The money goes back into their clubs for youth activities. This is the only way that we can run the league. Please inform your parents.
