2013 AAU TOURNAMENT RULES**

IMPORTANT: GYMS WILL ONLY BE OPEN 15 MINUTES PRIOR TO FIRST SCHEDULED GAME OF THE DAY.

- 1. NO FOOD OR DRINKS ALLOWED IN ANY GYMS.**
2. Coaches are responsible for their fans.
3. Coaches and parents of all teams must pick up their own trash at the game.
4. A Gym Supervisor is assigned at each gym to answer any questions or to forward any questions to Tournament Coordinator.
5. Rosters must be finalized before first game.
6. Using an illegal player will result in forfeit of tournament games and tournament entry fee.
7. **HIGH SCHOOL FEDERATION RULES WILL BE IN EFFECT, WITH THE EXCEPTIONS BELOW.**
8. Quarters: 7 minutes for 5th – 7th grade
8 minutes for 8th grade
- 9 a.. 5 minute pre-game warm-up.
b. 2 minute half time
c. 1 minute between 1st/2nd quarters and 3rd/4th quarters.
- 10 a. 3 Full time-outs (one minute)
b. 2 (30 second time outs) per game.
11. The 3-point rule in effect at all gyms.
12. “Overtime” of a game – 2-minutes
13. “Forfeit” of a game – 10 minutes after the scheduled game time.
- 14.. Scorekeeper: Each team is to have one person keep the individual score sheet that will be provided.
- 15.a. **TECHNICAL FOUL RULE:** Any technical foul awards automatic two points to the opposing team and possession of the ball out of bounds.
b.. A technical foul also counts as a personal foul. Two technical fouls on any one player or coach in any one game will result in automatic suspension from play or coaching for the remainder of the tournament.
16. **INTENTIONAL FOUL RULE:** Any foul that is deliberate or intentional gives two foul shots to the opposing team and the opposing team gets the ball out of bounds closest to the infraction.
17. **PRESS RULE:** Any team with an advantage of 15 points is required to pull off the full court press. After one warning from the official, if the press is not discontinued; the officials will assess a technical foul against the bench.
18. **BALL SIZE:** Girls Grades 5 through 8 - 28.5” circumference
Boys Grades 5 through 6 - 28.5” circumference
Boys 7th and 8th - 30.0” circumference (standard size)
