New Tournament for Girls: Sunnyside Easter Basketball Tournament NO SUNDAY GAMES - Easter Weekend, but it is only two days, Friday and Saturday. Teams will play three games. Must be able to play on Friday. Great tournament for the Christian Schools that don't play on Sunday or have players on your team that can't play on Sunday because of religious commitments. Entry Fee is only \$100.00. We are only taking 8 teams per division. If we have 16 teams we will do two divisions and divide the teams in ability. Entry form is on the web site.
